**Recently Completed** Newton, MA

All of our lot surrounded by mature trees provides a serene setting for this new stone home. A gravel floor parking through a stone walk leads to a granite front walk. A series of limestone terraces create a path to a beautiful rock and large overlooking terrace in the rear yard.
